

## Black-tailed Godwit

I have just received this back from Tomas Gunnarsson at the University of East Anglia.

The Black-tailed Godwit with the combination Left Leg White over Yellow - Right Leg Light Green over Red was ringed as a small chick on 07.07.03 at Mosfell, Grimsnes. Southern ICELAND. It has also been record once previously on 07.12.03 at Baie du Mont St. Michel, FRANCE.



The other bird is part of the Nene/Ouse Washes project and the details will be forwarded as soon as Dr Jenny Gill can do so!

I got this information back from Dr. Jenny Gill (University of East Anglia) this morning. Interestingly, it is an "icelandica" race bird and not part of the Nene/Ouse Washes population which are nominate "limosa" birds. Jenny is only in possession of the ringing info because the rings were put on in England.

The bird was ringed at Terrington, The Wash, NORFOLK (Spit - yuk!!) 31.08.03

It has subsequently been reported at Cley, Norfolk (Spit-yuk etc,etc....)29.09.03
