3/7-4/8/2005. Singles on eight dates.

One on 17/8/2005.

Blood-vein

Double brooded. Three singles 26/5-23/6 with 2 on 18/6/2005.  
15/7-18/8/2005. 1-2 on ten dates with 3 on 12/8. A further six singles  
from 2/9-8/9.

Lace Border

One on 31/8/2005. 3rd Thanet record.

Mullein Wave

Double brooded. One on 9/5, then seven singles from 25/5-12/7/2005,  
with 2 on 27/5 and 3 on 27/6.  
27/7-6/10/2005. 1-4 on many dates, commonest during August.

Small Blood-vein

24/6-10/8/2005. 1-2 on eighteen dates. One on 21/9, presumably from  
a partial 2nd brood.

Rosy Wave

Singles on 18/6 and 24/8/2005.

Least Carpet

28/6-13/9/2005. Nearly every night in July and August.  
10-21 on sixteen dates.

Small Fan-footed Wave

2/7-4/8/2005. 1-3 on fourteen dates.

Dwarf Cream Wave

29/6-4/8/2005. 1-3 on twenty-one dates.

Small Dusty Wave

At least double brooded. Three on 27/5 and 1 on 9/6, then 1-7 every  
night from 19/6-23/7/2005.  
Just five singles 2/8-23/8, then 1-9 nearly every night from 26/8-27/9  
with 12-16 on four dates. Finally one on 9/10.

Single-dotted Wave

28/6-2/9/2005. 1-7 on most nights.

Satin Wave

Double brooded. 5/6-21/7/2005. 1-3 on eleven dates – most in June.  
16/8-10/9/2005. Singles on ten dates with 5 on 31/8 and 2 on 5/9.

Treble Brown Spot

One on 9/6 and then 1-10 on every night from 17/6-30/6/2005.  
In July, 1-3 on most nights until 23rd.

Riband Wave

18/6-4/9/2005. Nearly every night. 10-21 on sixteen dates with 33 on 15/7. Commonest during July.

Vestal

Singles on 22/8, 2/9, 15/10 and 27/10/2005.

Gem

One on 29/7/2005. Five singles from 6/10-3/11.

Flame Carpet

One on 1/8/2005.

Red Twin-spot Carpet

Double brooded. Singles on 6/5 and 25/5 with 4 on 26/5 and 6 on 27/5 10/7-20/9/2005. Singles on six dates.

Dark-barred Twin-spot Carpet

Double brooded. One on 26/5/2005.  
15/7-4/9/2005. Singles on four dates.

Garden Carpet

At least two overlapping broods. 25/5-8/10/2005. 1-8 on most nights apart from July, when 1-12 on most nights.

Shaded Broad-bar

17/7-19/8/2005. Singles on six dates.

Ruddy Carpet

One on 24/6/2005.

Common Carpet

Double brooded. 1/5-3/7/2005. 1-5 on twenty-one dates with 11 on 27/5.  
15/7-25/9/2005. 1-5 on most nights with 7 on 30/8 and 9 on 31/8.

Galium Carpet

Double brooded. Singles on 27/5 and 22/6/2005.  
11/7-6/9/2005. Singles on nine dates.

Yellow Shell

Double brooded. 27/5-30/6/2005. 1-7 on most nights with 10 on 9/6.  
4/9-30/10/2005. 1-6 on many dates with 8 on 18/9.

Barred Yellow

15/6-15/7/2005. Singles on seven dates.

Blue-bordered Carpet

Singles on 12/7 and 30/7/2005.

Grey Pine Carpet

Double brooded. Singles on 26/5, 6/6 and 19/6 with 2 on 27/5/2005.  
Four singles from 18/9-28/10/2005.

Spruce Carpet

Double brooded. Four singles from 3/5-27/5/2005.

1-2 on just five dates.

Double brooded. Singles on 25/5 and 26/5 with 2 on 27/5/2005.

At least double brooded. 6/5-28/5/2005. 1-5 every night with 11 on  
26/5 and 14 on 27/5. Infrequent in June/July. 1-6 on nine dates from  
5/6-24/6 and singles on six dates from 9/7-21/7.  
One on 2/8, then 1-8 every night from 8/8-14/9 with 10-15 on five  
dates. Further singles on 18/9 and 27/9.

Large Thorn

One on 20/8/2005.

Canary-shouldered Thorn

Singles on 29/8 and 11/9 with 2 on 12/9/2005.

Early Thorn

Double brooded. Singles on 4/4, 12/4 and 29/4/2005.  
12/7-10/8/2005. Singles on seven dates.

Scalloped Oak

30/6-17/8/2005. 1-4 on most nights.

Swallow-tailed Moth

9/7-27/7/2005. 1-3 on most nights with 6 on 14/7. One on 17/8.

Feathered Thorn

Two on 28/10, 3 on 30/10 and 1 on 3/11.

Peppered

31/5-10/8/2005. Singles on fourteen dates – all pale form.

Dotted Border

Singles on 24/3, 2/4 and 10/4/2005.

Willow Beauty

Perhaps two overlapping broods. 17/6-11/10/2005. 1-6 on most nights in June and 1-3 on many dates in July. 1-10 on most nights during August/September with 15 on 30/8, 12 on 31/8 and 6/9. A late single on 30/10.

Mottled Beauty

17/6-21/7/2005. 1-7 nearly every night with 12 on 21/6, 10 on 24/6 and 29/6.

Pale Oak Beauty

Singles on 17/6 and 21/6/2005.

7/7-19/8/2005. 1-7 nearly every night. A late single on 4/9/2005.

Pigmy Footman  
One 'pallifrons' on 3/7 and single 'pygmaeola' on 5/7 and 29/7.

Scarce Footman  
22/6-4/9/2005. Nearly every night. 10-19 on twenty-one dates.

Common Footman  
12/6-11/8. Nearly every night. 21-73 on fourteen dates with 94 on 17/7. Commonest during July.

Garden Tiger  
24/6-10/8/2005. Singles on seven dates.

White Ermine  
28/5-9/7/2005. 1-5 on most nights.

Buff Ermine  
6/6-10/8/2005. 1-4 on many dates in June, 1-6 on every night during July and 1-2 on most dates in August until 10th.

Muslin Moth  
10/4-28/5/2005. Singles on thirteen dates, 6 on 9/5, 5 on 11/5 and 3 on 15/5. Nearly all in May.

Ruby Tiger

13/7-2/9/2005. 1-3 on eighteen dates with 6 on 22/7.

Cinnabar

Singles on 15/5, 21/6 and 10/7/2005.

Kent Black Arches

Singles on 12/7, 3/8 and 9/8/2005.

Short Cloaked Moth

20/6-27/7/2005. 1-7 on twenty-one dates.

Least Black Arches

29/4-6/6/2005. 1-6 on ten dates.

One on 9/5, then 1-3 on many dates from 25/5-16/7/2005 with 4 on 27/5. 1-3 on most nights 31/7-31/8 and 1-6 on most nights during September. 1-2 on just seven dates in October and finally, 1 on 3/11.

Heart and Club

22/6-21/7/2005. 1-5 on most nights.

Heart and Dart

2/5-17/8/2005. Every night from 25/5-1/8. A poor year. 30-58 on just eight dates with 79 on 24/6. Commonest during June. Further singles on 4/9, 5/9 and 22/9.

Shuttle-shaped Dart

At least double brooded. One on 5/4, then 1-8 nearly every night from 29/4-27/6/2005 with 10 on 27/5.

16/7-20/10/2005. Every night July/August, commonest during August when 10-21 on fourteen dates with 29 on 10th. 1-5 most nights during September and 1-3 most nights during October.

Sand Dart

One on 15/6/2005.

Flame

8/6-25/7/2005. Most nights in June, every night in July. 8-12 on twelve dates with 19 on 24/6 and 17 on 10/7.

Flame Shoulder

Double brooded. 2/5-30/6/2005. Singles on seven dates in May with 3 on 27th, then 1-2 on most nights in June.

9/7-11/9/2005. 1-2 on many nights in July with 6 on 10th, then 1-8 on every night during August and 1-4 on most nights in September.

Large Yellow Underwing

27/5-1/11/2005. Every night 2/6-30/9. 1-18 June/July with 43 on 15/7. 1-48 during August with 67 on 30th and 98 on 31st.

30-78 on twelve dates in September with 93 on 5th. 1-10 in October

Lesser Yellow Underwing

23/6-29/10/2005. 1-25 nearly every night in July and until 5/8.

Then 1-2 on just five dates 9/8-16/8, not again until 21/8 after-which 1-18 every night. 2-26 on every night in September and 1-22 on most nights during October. A late single on 10/11.

Broad-bordered Yellow Underwing

2/7-18/9/2005. 1-5 on thirty-six dates.

Lesser Broad-bordered Yellow Underwing

2/7-23/9/2005. 1-12 on most nights during July with 15 on 31st.

Every night 1/8-6/9, typically 22-62. Only four singles after 6/9.

Langmaid's Yellow Underwing

One on 2/8/2005. Migrant or recent colonist.

Least Yellow Underwing

5/7-11/9/2005. 1-2 on nineteen dates.

Double brooded. 24/5-20/7/2005. 1-17 every night.

2/8-9/10/2005. 10-49 on twenty-nine dates with 53 on 31/8.

A late single on 21/11.

Six-striped Rustic

Bright-line Brown-eye

Singles on 18/4, 5/5 and 6/5/2005. Then 1-12 on every night from  
24/5-30/6. Every night during July with 10-27 on fifteen dates.  
Then 1-12 nearly every night from 1/8-24/9. Finally, 1 on 2/10.

Broad-barred White

Singles on 29/4, 9/6 and 16/6/2005. Then 1-3 on sixteen dates from  
9/7-19/8/2005.

Small Ranunculus

One on 21/7/2005. The 1st Thanet record.

Campion

Double brooded. 20/5-19/6/2005. Singles on four dates.  
18/7-19/9/2005. Singles on twelve dates with 2 on 29/8.

Varied Coronet

Singles on 10/7 and 17/7/2005.

Lychnis

Double brooded. 5/5-17/6/2005. Singles on four dates.  
11/7-26/8/2005. Singles on six dates.

Feathered Gothic

One 12/9/2005.

Pine Beauty

Singles on 29/4, 26/5 and 27/5/2005.

Small Quaker

21/3-12/4/2005. 1-3 on eleven dates.

Blossom Underwing

One on 9/4/2005. Presumably a migrant.

Lead-coloured Drab

A female on 24/3/2005 – very rare on Thanet.

Powdered Quaker

One on 11/4/2005.

Common Quaker

17/3-5/5/2005. 1-3 on ten dates in March, then 1-9 on most nights  
with 15 on 2/4. A late single on 6/6/2005.

Clouded Drab

23/3-1/5/2005. 1-3 on eleven dates with 6 on 2/4. A late single on 6/6.

Twin-spot Quaker

22/3-4/4/2005. 1-2 on five dates.

Hebrew Character

15/3-15/5/2005. 1-7 on most nights.

Brown-line Bright-eye

30/6-12/8/2005. 1-8 on most nights.

Clay

29/6-13/8/2005. 1-4 on most nights.

A migrant now breeding locally, masking the extent of any immigration.  
Double brooded. 24/5-11/7/2005. 1-6 on twenty-eight dates with 8 on 5/6. A 1st brood total of 77.  
4/8-24/9/2005. Every night from 8/8-18/9. 1-12 with 14 on 31/8.  
Further singles on 5/10, 7/10 and 16/10. A 2nd brood total of 166.
