

Kingsdown - Sunday 6th August 2006

1 x 125mv trap plus Beadle's special 'gloop' (sugar/beer/banana) which did attract c.half a dozen species soon after dark but little else as the night wore on. Moths to the gloop mixture were: 3 - 4 Old Lady, Large Yellow Underwing, Copper Underwing, Dark Arches and a Herald.

Weather: Hot humid evening giving way to a clear (and damp) sky soon after darkness with cloud cover moving in after midnight. Wind light and from the south to s/east. A poor night for moths - after a month or two of drought conditions locally. Little in the way of local species on the wing or migrants.

It was an all night session.
